We are pleased to invite you to attend the 17th International Conference on RF Superconductivity, SRF 2015, to take place from September 13-18, 2015 in the Whistler Conference Centre in Whistler, British Columbia, Canada. Whistler is a spectacular four-season tourist destination 125 km north of Vancouver. The conference web-site is now available at http://srf2015.triumf.ca and will be updated frequently in the coming weeks and months.

The SRF conference series provides a vibrant forum for scientists, engineers, students and industrial partners to present and discuss the latest developments in the science and technology of superconducting RF for particle accelerator applications. For 2015 we are moving the conference series from the large urban locales of the past few events to a more intimate environment with plenty of opportunities for end-of-day gatherings at Whistler's many restaurants and pubs. The program will consist of invited talks, poster sessions and 'hot-topic' discussion sessions as well as social activities in a beautiful mountain setting. An industrial exhibition will also take place during the conference.

Following tradition, SRF2015 tutorial sessions will be held prior to the conference from Sept. 10-12 at the Delta Whistler Village Suites. The tutorials are designed to provide an in-depth overview of SRF related subjects for students as well as scientists and engineers new to the field. Some financial support for students will be available.

The proceedings will be published through JACoW with the conference database managed through JACoW's SPMS system. Registration and the call for contributions will be initiated in February 2015 with the second announcement.

The conference logo is `SRF Inukshuk'. Historically the Inukshuk is an Inuit stone monument used, for example, as a geographical point of reference and lately has become a symbol of good will and welcoming across Canada. In that spirit we welcome you to join us for SRF2015.
