TRIUMF TOUR SAFETY INFORMATION

At TRIUMF, your safety is a primary concern for us. In this document we have outlined some important safety information that you must review before coming to TRIUMF.

- Pacemaker/ICD Warning: Due to the magnetic fields present on the TRIUMF site, people with heart pacemakers or ICDs (implantable cardioverter defibrillators) may be at risk. Please inform your tour guide if anyone in your group has a heart pacemaker as the guide will have to take an alternate route.
- Radiation Safety: Tour participants must stay together with the tour guides at all times for the duration of the tour.
- **Footwear:** It is very important that you wear a flat-soled loafer or athletic footwear for this tour. High heeled footwear is not appropriate due to metal grate platforms and stairways along the route. These metal grates pose a high risk of personal injury due to falls or sprains if one wears inappropriate footwear.
- Children: TRIUMF forbids unsupervised children under 13 from entering the TRIUMF facility. If children under 13 attend the tour, a parent or guardian must accompany each of them at all times and must be responsible for their safety.
- Bags: Large bags/knapsacks are not permitted to be brought on-site. We ask, therefore, that you do not bring any bags with you to the tour. If you plan to depart Vancouver directly from TRIUMF, you will be asked to leave your luggage in the bus. However, cameras are allowed on TRIUMF tours.

A 'Designated' TRIUMF Level II First Aider is in attendance. In the event you require first aid, dial local '7333', report the type of injury, and the location. STAY ON THE PHONE! until all the information has been noted by the our staff. A first aid attendant will arrive in a few minutes.
